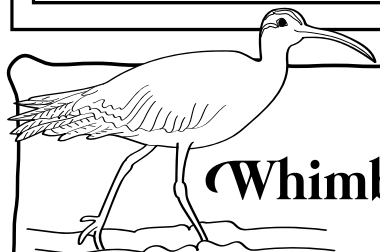


Pismo Beach Seabirds

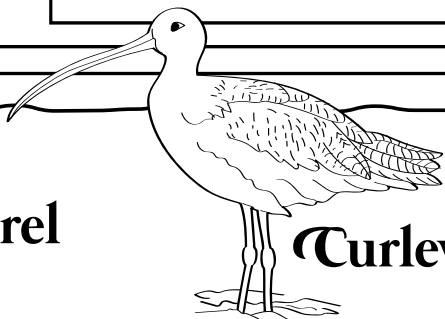
Pismo Beach's seabirds rely on a clean and peaceful environment to thrive and survive.

Help them conduct their activities naturally and keep them safe:

- Keep your dog on leash. Don't let your dog chase the birds.
- Observe them quietly. Keep a respectful distance.
- Stay out of nesting areas to protect their chicks and eggs.
- Do not chase, harass, or scatter the birds.
- Do not feed the birds your food – it can make them ill.
- Dispose of your trash properly. Trash can choke, entangle, and sicken the birds.



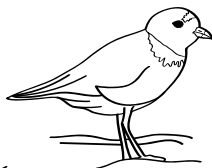

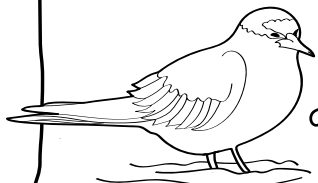
Curlew



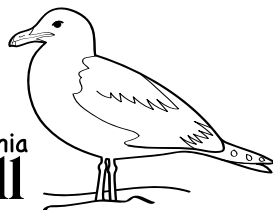

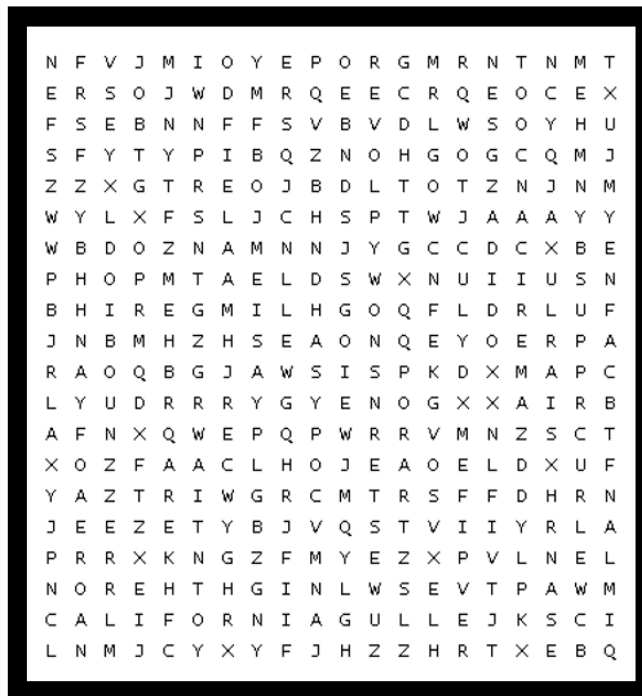

Pismo Beach Seabird Word Search

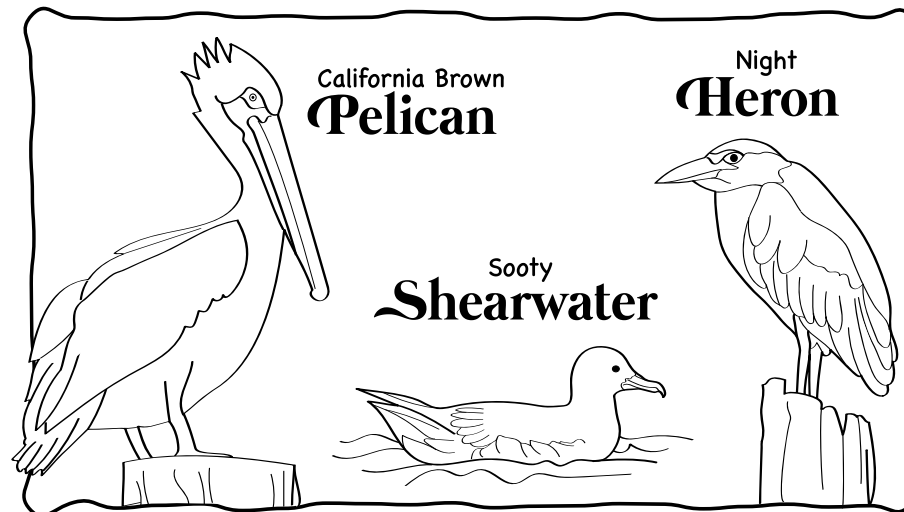
Find and circle/highlight seabird names in the puzzle. Words can go in any direction. Words can share letters as they cross over each other
